### HIGHWAYS ACT 1980, SECTION 118 AND SECTION 119

#### Notice of Proposal to Modify Public Path Order

Notice is hereby given pursuant to paragraph 2 (3) of the Sixth Schedule to the Highways Act 1980 that the Inspector appointed by the Secretary of State for the Environment to determine the Warwickshire County Council—Footpaths SD 97A and SD 97C Kineton Extinguishment Order 1984 and Bridleway SD 97 and Footpath 97B Kineton—Diversion Order 1983 proposes to modify the Order by providing for in Part B of the Diversion Order:

(i) The deletion of "Bridleway SD 97, between points A, G, H, I, J, K, L, E, and M on the map annexed hereto" and substitute "bridleway SD 97, between A, G, H, I, J, K, P, Q, on the map annexed hereto" also in part B of the Diversion Order delete

(ii) "and turning to head westwards . . . Red House Farm" and substitute "and turning to head north-north-eastwards for approximately 70 metres then turning south-south-eastwards for 180 metres, and then proceeding generally in a south-west and south-south-west direction for approximately 400 metres to point Q on Holt Road adjacent to the south-east corner of OS field 3000 and the south-west corner of the disused Brickworks, approximately 610 metres north-east of Red House Farm"

and the following modification to the Public Path Extinguishment Order 1984

(i) delete all reference therein to footpath SD 97C.

A copy of the Order and map as submitted and a copy of a map showing the proposed modification have been deposited at the Shire Hall, Warwick and at the office of the district Secretary and Solicitor of the Stratford-on-Avon DC, Council Offices, Church Street, Stratford-upon-Avon and may be inspected free of charge during normal office hours. Any representation or objection with respect to the proposed modification may be sent in writing to the Secretary of State, Department of the Environment (quoting ref. FPS/5077/3/2 and FPS/5077/4/3) not later than 26th June 1986 and should state the grounds on which it is made.

### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

#### TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING GENERAL REGULATIONS 1976

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has made an Order entitled "The Extinguishment of Vehicular Rights (County of Derbyshire) (No. 2) Order 1986". The Order comes into operation on 23rd May 1986 and extinguishes any right which persons may have to use vehicles (other than those specified in Schedule 2 to the Order) on Part of Noel Street, Derby.

If any person aggrieved by the Order desires to question its validity, or the validity of any provision contained in it, on the ground that it is not within the powers conferred by the above Act or that any requirement of that Act or of any regulation made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, he or she may, within 6 weeks from 23rd May 1986 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained in it.

Unless the Order is suspended or quashed as a consequence of any such application, any person who on 23rd May 1986 has had an interest in land having lawful access to a highway to which the Order relates may claim to be entitled to be compensated by the Council in respect of any depreciation in the value of his or her interest which is directly attributable to the Order and of any other loss or damage which is so attributable. Any claim must be served on the Council at its above address within a period of 6 months from 23rd May 1986 unless the period is extended in any particular case by the Secretary of State.
