NOTICE OF APPLICATION FOR LICENCE TO OBSTRUCT OR IMPEDE THE FLOW OF AN INLAND WATER BY MEANS OF IMPOUNDING WORKS

Notice is hereby given that an application is being made to the Severn-Trent Water Authority by L. C. Corfield & Son of Lower Hill Farm, Hughley, Near Shrewsbury, Shropshire for a licence to obstruct or impede the flow of a spring flowing off Wenlock Edge in the Parish of Hughley, District of Shrewsbury & Atcham by means of 6 clay embankments between NGR SO 581 981 and SO 577 987.

The object of impounding water by means of the works is to provide pools for fishing. The capacity of the reservoir at overflow level will be 10,300/7,500/5,600/5,800/6,000/12,000 cubic metres respectively.
