## NEW FOREST DISTRICT COUNCIL

District of New Forest (Off-street Parking Places) (Amendment) Order 1986

Notice is hereby given that the District Council of New Forest propose to make the above-named Order in exercise of their powers under section 35(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act") and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Act, and of all other enabling powers.

The effect of the above-named Order will be to amend the provisions of the District of New Forest (Off-street Parking Places)

Order 1983 ("the Principal Order") in the following respects namely:

(1) (i) The Principal Order provides that for use of any of the Amenity Parking Places set out below, 30p. is payable for each period of 2 hours during charging hours, namely 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. March to October inclusive. The above-named Order provides that the charge will be 40p. for each period of 2 hours during charging hours.

(ii) The Principal Order provides that for use of any of the Amenity Parking Places set out below there is a maximum

charge of £1 per day. The above-named Order provides that the maximum charge will be £1.20.

(2) The Principal Order provides that the excess charge is £10. The above-named Order provides that the excess charge will be £12

(3) By the addition of further parking places as follows:

(i) Part II of the Schedule to the Principal Order shall be deemed to include the parking place specified in column 1 of Part I of the Schedule hereto.

(ii) Part III of the Schedule to the Principal Order shall be deemed to include the parking place specified in column 1 of Part II of the Schedule hereto.

Full details of the proposals are contained in the draft of the above-named Order which together with the Principal Order and statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the above-named Order may be examined during normal office hours at:
