ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

Humberside County Council The Liverpool-Leeds-Hull Trunk Road (A63) (South Docks Road, Hull) (Daltry Street Flyover) Prohibition of Pedestrians and Prohibition of Pedal Cycling Order 1986.

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that on 6th June 1986, he made an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) and (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 which comes into operation on 11th June 1986.

Any person who desires to question the validity of, or of any provision contained in, the Order, on the ground that it is not within the powers with respect to the Order conferred by the above Act, or on the ground that any requirement of, or of any Instrument made under, any provision of that Act has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, within 6 weeks of the 6th June 1986, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

HIGHWAYS ACT 1985

The Birmingham-Great Yarmouth (A47) Trunk Road (Postwick-Blofield Dualling Side Roads) Order 1986

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that, in relation to the above mentioned Trunk Road between Postwick and Blofield in the County of Norfolk, he has made under sections 12 and 14 of the Highways Act 1980 an Order, the effect of which is:

- (a) to authorise him:
- (i) to improve, raise lower or otherwise alter lengths of highways,
 - (ii) to stop up lengths of highways, and
- (iii) to construct new highways,
- all between Postwick and Blofield aforesaid, and
- (b) to provide for the transfer of each of the said new highways to the County Council of Norfolk as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the new highway has been completed and is open for through traffic.
