WATER RESOURCES (LICENCES) REGULATIONS 1965

Notice of Application for a Licence to obstruct or impede the flow of an inland water by means of impounding works.

Notice is hereby given that the Anglican Water Authority (Cambridge Division), propose to impound the Loughton Brook and the Shenley Arm of the Loughton Brook, a short distance upstream of their confluence by means of an earth DAM at NGR SP 849 360 at Shenley Brook End, Milton Keynes, Buckinghamshire.

The object of the impounding works is the creation of a Flood Control Balancing Lake approximately 28 hectares to be known as Furzton Reservoir and excavated to facilitate amenity activities. The Dam incorporates an emergency spilling level at 83.5 metres (Ordnance Datum Newlyn). The creation of the lake will submerge the lengths of the two said brooks between NGR SP 849 360 to SP 844 359 and SP 849 360 to SP 850 353.

The proposals will be effected by means of Licence to Impound Serial No. 6/33/5/50/90P, a draft of which and plans have been placed on deposit at the offices of the Borough of Milton Keynes, Civic Offices, 1 Saxon Gate East, Milton Keynes, and may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours during the period beginning on 7th June 1986 and ending on 7th July 1986.

NOTICE OF APPLICATIONS TO VARY LICENCES TO ABSTRACT WATER

Notice is hereby given that applications are being made to the Southern Water Authority by:

- (1) *Kelsey Farms Limited*, Quaives Farm, Wickhambreaux to vary licence no. 9/40/4/432/S to abstract water from the Blackhole Dyke at Wickhambreaux and;
- (2) *E. H. Holdstock & Sons*, Elbridge Farm, Sturry, to vary licence no. 9/40/4/82/SR to abstract water from the Newnham Stream at Wickhambreaux.

The variations applied for are to delete the licence condition controlling abstraction by reference to the flow of the Little Stour at Seaton Bridge and replace this with a condition based on the flow at Plucks Gutter. It is an essential aspect of these applications that a new weir will be constructed on the Blackhole Dyke downstream of Wickhambreaux at Grid ref. TR 225 590 to reduce the impact of the abstractions on the Little Stour at Wickhambreaux where the flow of the river reaches a minimum. The previous applications by *Kelsey Farms Ltd.* and *E. H. Holdstock & Sons* to reduce the Seaton Bridge flow condition from 5 million gallons per day to 3 million gallons per day will be withdrawn should these applications be approved.
