DYFED COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Dyfed (Upper Frog Street and St. Nicholas Lane, Tenby) (Seasonal Prohibition of Driving) Order 1986

Notice is hereby given that on 4th June 1986 the Dyfed County Council made an Order under sections 1 (1) and (2), 2 (1) to (3) and 3 (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act").

The effect of the Order is to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in those roads known as Upper Frog Street and St. Nicholas Lane, Tenby, between the hours of 2 p.m. and 10 p.m. on any day during the period commencing 1st May and terminating on 30th September in each year.

Exceptions are provided in the Order to permit vehicles to use the said roads for:

- (a) Road repair or other similar works by public authorities.
- (b) Fire brigade, police or ambulance purposes.

In addition the Order contains an exemption to enable the owner or occupier of any off-street parking area to which there is no vehicular access other than through Upper Frog Street and St. Nicholas Lane and to whom a permit has been issued to gain access in a specified vehicle to the said off-street parking area during the prohibited period.

Applications for permits should be made as soon as possible to the Town Clerk, Tenby Town Council, De Valence Pavilion, Upper Frog Street, Tenby.

The Order will come into operation on 16th June 1986 and a copy of the Order, together with a map showing the roads affected, may be examined at the offices of the Dyfed County Council at County Hall, Carmarthen, during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of this Order, or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

DYFED COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Dyfed (Walled Town, Tenby) (Experimental Seasonal Road Traffic Regulation) (Amendment) Order 1986.

Notice is hereby given that on 4th June 1986 the Dyfed County Council made an Order under section 9 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act").

The effect of the Order is to amend the County of Dyfed (Walled Town, Tenby) (Experimental Seasonal Road Traffic Regulation) Order 1986 one of the provisions of which is to prohibit any motor vehicle from entering or proceeding in any of the roads in Tenby specified in the Schedule to this notice on any day during the period commencing 1st May and terminating on 30th September in each year.

An exemption is provided in the Order to permit motor vehicles to use the said roads for the purpose of conveying persons, goods or merchandise to or from any premises situated on or adjacent to those roads.

The following words have been added to the said exemption "or if the motor vehicle is a hackney carriage or a private hire vehicle".

The Order will come into operation on 9th June 1986 and a copy of the Order, together with a map showing the roads affected, may be inspected at the offices of Dyfed County Council at County Hall, Carmarthen, during normal office hours.

Any person who desires to question the validity of this Order, or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Act, or on the grounds that any requirement of the Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of the date on which the Order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

DYFED COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Dyfed (Upper and Lower Frog Street and The Paragon, Tenby) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1986.

Notice is hereby given that the Dyfed County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1) and (2), 2 (1) to (3) and 4 (2) of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The Order will include provisions the effect of which will be:

- (1) To prohibit waiting at any time in the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.
- (2) To revoke the County of Dyfed (Various Roads, Tenby) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1980 in so far as it relates to the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

The Order will contain the usual exemptions including the right of passengers to board or alight from a vehicle, for the loading and unloading of goods, for the carrying out of building operations and other works and for the performance of statutory powers or duties.

In addition the Order will contain the usual parking concessions for disabled persons in accordance with the "orange badge" scheme.

Full details of this proposal are contained in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the length of road affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at the offices of the Dyfed County Council at County Hall, Carmarthen, and at the South Pembrokeshire District Council's Information Bureau, The Croft, Tenby, during normal office hours.

If you wish to object to the above provisions you should send the grounds for your objection in writing to the undersigned by 30th June 1986.
