- (b) provide that the parking places would be in operation between 8.30 a.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive (Christmas Day, Good Friday and Bank Holidays excepted);
- (c) specify, in respect of the parking places, that passenger vehicles (12 seats or less), goods carrying vehicles, motorcycles or invalid carriages may be left therein;

- (d) provide that certain other vehicles may wait in the parking places in certain circumstances, e.g. to allow persons to board or alight, to load or unload (maxi-mum 20 minutes), etc.
