In the Matter of an Application under section 42 of The Supreme Court Act 1981 in respect of GEORGE FRANK SAYER.

Upon Reading the Notice of Motion on behalf of the Applicant H.M. Attorney General dated 11th October 1985 for an Order pursuant to section 42 of the Supreme Court Act 1981 in respect of the Respondent George Frank Sayer.

And upon Reading the Affidavit in support of the Motion of Jayant Desai sworn on 10th October 1985 together with the exhibit referred to therein.

And upon Hearing Mr. R. Jay of Counsel on behalf of H.M. Attorney General there being no appearance by or on behalf of the Respondent.

And no Order having been sought as to costs.

It is Ordered pursuant to section 42 of The Supreme Court Act 1981 (as amended):

(i) No Civil proceedings shall without the leave of the High Court or a Judge thereof be instituted by George Frank Sayer in any Court, and

(ii) That any Civil proceedings instituted by George Frank Sayer in any Court before the making of the Order shall not be continued by the said George Frank Sayer without the leave of the High Court and

(iii) That no application (other than an application for leave under this section) shall without the leave of the High Court be made by George Frank Sayer in any Civil proceedings instituted whether by him or another in any Court.

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 209 of the above Act to authorise the stopping-up of a portion of Magpie Bottom Lane at Kingswood to enable residential development to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to Costain Homes (South Western) by Kingswood District Council under Part III of the said Act.

The proposed Order will require the provision of new highways maintainable at the public expense for which the Highway Authority is to be the Avon County Council.

During 28 days from 4th August 1986 copies of the draft Order and relevant plan may be inspected at all reasonable hours at the Kingswood District Council Offices, Civic Centre, High Street, Kingswood, Bristol and may be obtained, free of charge, from the Department of Transport (ref.
