

THAMESDOWN BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Thamesdown (Parking Places) (Pay and Display) (Amendment) Order 1986

Notice is hereby given that the Thamesdown Borough Council propose to make an Order under sections 35 and 124 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers, the effect of which is to further amend the Borough of Thamesdown (Parking Places) (Pay and Display) Order 1984 Hereinafter referred to as "the 1984 Order") as follows:

- (a) to introduce the undermentioned revised charges for the parking of vehicles at the parking places in Swindon comprised in the 1984 Order, except for North Star car park, levels 1, 2 and 3 Carlton and levels 1, 2, 3 and 4 Fleming Way car parks;
- (b) to provide for Long Stay car parking (yellow code) on Level 5 Brunel car park, Swindon;
- (c) to permit Long Stay (yellow code) season ticket holders to park on Level 3 Carlton car park, Swindon;
- (d) to include the whole of Level 5 Spring Gardens car park, and Beckhampton Street car park in Swindon on all days, within the provisions or requirements of the 1984 Order (as amended);
- (e) to increase the amount of the excess charge to £10, which shall be further increased to £15 if not paid within 28 days of the offence;
- (f) to increase the amount of the immediate payment, in lieu of the full excess charge, from £2 to £3;
- (g) to prohibit the use of Henry Street, Devizes Road and Carlton car parks in Swindon by goods vehicles over 30 cwt. unladen weight and coaches;
- (h) to include within the provisions of the 1984 Order (as amended) a temporary car park at North Star Avenue, Swindon for goods vehicles over 30 cwt. unladen weight and coaches for a period not exceeding 12 hours (maximum stay permitted 24 hours) at a fee of £2 per 12 hour period.

Middlesbrough Borough Council The (Residents Parking Scheme and Gresham Ward Traffic Management Scheme) Amendment Order 1986

Notice is hereby given that the Middlesbrough Borough Council propose to make an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of this Order is to replace Schedule 1 of the Middlesbrough Borough Council (Gresham Ward Traffic Management Scheme) Order 1985 "the Traffic Management Order" and Schedule 2 of the Middlesbrough Borough Council (Residents Parking Scheme) Order 1985 "the Residents Parking Order" with new Schedules 1 and 2.

A144 The Street and Halesworth Hill	From a point 100 metres south of the A144/C205/C208 crossroads in a northerly direction for a distance of 982 metres.
C205 Bridge Street and Thorington Road	From its junction with the A144 in an easterly direction for a distance of 670 metres.
C208 Walpole Road	From its junction with the A144 in a westerly direction for a distance of 140 metres.
