(iv) limit the waiting of vehicles to 1 hour in any 4 hours between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on any day other than a Sunday in the length of road at Truro specified in the Fourth Schedule; and
(v) amend existing traffic regulation Orders as necessary

to give effect to the foregoing.

The Restrictions on Waiting Order will contain exceptions to (iii) and (iv) above in favour of disabled persons vehicles in accordance with the Orange Badge Scheme and to allow boarding and alighting; loading and unloading (except as in (iii) above); delivery and collection of postal packets; statutory powers or duties; building operations; works on roads and services; the taking in of petrol, etc., from a garage; and funerals.
