

DERBYSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Derbyshire County Council (Oakleys Road Area, Long Eaton) (Weight Restriction) Order 1986

Notice is hereby given that the Derbyshire County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1), (2), 2 (4) and 3 (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers.

The effect of this Order will be to prohibit any person from causing or permitting any goods vehicle the maximum permissible gross weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

Exemptions will be provided in the Order for:

- (a) The purpose of access to premises on or adjacent to the lengths of road;
- (b) The purpose of agriculture in connection with land adjacent to the lengths of road;
- (c) In connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or re-construction, the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of a telegraphic line, as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878 in or adjacent to the lengths of road;
- (d) For fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (e) In the course of military training operations;
- (f) The passage of winter maintenance vehicles.

Full details of the proposal are in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the restricted lengths of road and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined at Room 108, County Offices, Matlock (Mrs. J. Senior), and at the offices of the Director of Technical Services, Erewash Borough Council, Town Hall, Long Eaton, during normal office hours on Monday to Friday.

If you wish to object to the proposed Order you should send the grounds for your objection in writing to the undersigned by Monday, 22nd September 1986.

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

The Devon County Council (Various Streets, Bideford) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1986

Notice is hereby given that the Devon County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1, 2, 3 and 4 and part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which will be:

- (a) to impose one-way traffic in Market Place, Silver Street, Buttergarden Street and Honestone Street;
- (b) to prohibit waiting at all times in specified lengths of Market Place;
- (c) to prohibit waiting between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday in specified lengths of Market Place and the proposed loading bay in the unnamed road at its junction with Market Place and Buttgarden Street;
- (d) to limit waiting to 30 minutes (no return within 2 hours) between 9 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday in a specified length of Market Place;
- (e) to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in a specified length of the unnamed road between Silver Street and Buttgarden Street/Market Place;
- (f) to impose a width restriction of 2 metres (6 feet 6 inches) on Silver Street.

The proposed Order will contain the usual exemptions where applicable relating to picking up and setting down of passengers loading and unloading goods, disabled per-

sons' vehicles and the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water and electricity.

Full details of the proposals and exemptions are contained in the draft Order which together with a plan illustrating the restrictions and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined during normal office hours Monday to Friday at either Room 510, Civic Centre, Barnstaple or Torridge District Council Offices, Town Hall, Bideford.

Objections to the proposal, specifying the grounds on which they are made must be submitted in writing to the undersigned by not later than 23rd September 1986.

The County of Devon (Various Street, Teignmouth) (One-Way) (Comprehensive) Order 1986

Notice is hereby given that Devon County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1 (1) and (2), 2 (1)-(3) and Part 4 of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

When the Order comes into effect, you will not be allowed to drive any vehicle in Northumberland Place, Teignmouth, between its junction with Somerset Place and Devon Arms other than in the direction from north to south, that is from Somerset Place towards Devon Arms.

There is the usual exemption in the Order for road cleansing vehicles between the hours of midnight and 8 a.m.
