GLOUCESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Gloucestershire County Council (Trier Way, Part 2) (General Traffic Regulation) Order 198

Notice is hereby given that the Gloucestershire County Council intend to make an Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 affecting the road which it is proposing to construct between Park Road at its junction with Parkend Road and the junction of Southgate Street and Bristol Road and which will be known as Trier Way in the City of Gloucester.

The effect of the Order will be:

- (1) to prohibit any vehicle proceeding along a road specified in Schedule I to this notice from making a U-turn at any of the locations specified in the Schedule in relation to the road so as to proceed in the opposite direction;
- (2) to prohibit any vehicle from making a left hand turn from any of the roads specified in column 1 of Schedule II to this notice into any of the roads specified in column 2;
- (3) to prohibit any vehicle from making a right hand turn from the road specified in column 1 of Schedule III to this notice into any of the roads specified in column 2;

(4) to impose a left-hand turn only for vehicles proceeding from the Park access road into Trier Way;

(5) to prohibit any vehicle proceeding along Trier Way from entering Parkend Road at its westernmost junction with Trier Way;

(6) to prohibit any vehicle from being driven into a boxed area of the southbound carriageway of Trier Way at its junction with the access road leading to Midland Road, known as California Crossing, and being marked by cross-hatched yellow lines bounded by a yellow line on the carriageway when it becomes necessary owing to the presence of stationary vehicles for any part of the vehicle to remain at rest within the area.

A copy of the draft Order together with a statement of reasons and relevant plan may be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of Gloucestershire County Council, Shire Hall, Westgate Street, Gloucester, and the City Engineer, Cedar House, 8 Spa Road, Gloucester. Any objection to the proposals together with the grounds on which it is made must be sent in writing to reach the undersigned by 29th September 1986.
