

HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The County Council of Warwickshire (Attleborough Bypass) (Side Roads) Order 1985

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he has confirmed with modification the above Order which was made by the County Council of Warwickshire under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980, and which, as confirmed, provides for authorising the Council:

- (a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways,
- (b) to stop up highways,
- (c) to construct new highways, and
- (d) to stop up private means of access to premises,

all on or in the vicinity of the route of the classified road A4254 which the Council are proposing to construct from Garrett Street/Highfield Road junction to Attleborough Road/Avenue Road/Bull Street junction, at Attleborough Nuneaton in the County of Warwickshire.

Copies of the Order as confirmed and of the relevant plan may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours at the offices of the Clerk of the Council, Shire Hall, Warwick; the Council House, Nuneaton, and at the Department of Transport, West Midlands Region, Five Ways Tower, Frederick Road, Edgbaston, Birmingham B15 1SJ.

Any person aggrieved by the Order and desiring to question the validity thereof, or of any provision contained therein, on the ground that it is not within the powers of the Highways Act 1980, or on the ground that any requirement of that Act or of any regulations made thereunder has not been complied with in relation to the Order, may, within 6 weeks of 26th September 1986, apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

CROUCH HARBOUR ACT 1974

Appeal by Bambergers (Transportation) Limited against the refusal of the Crouch Harbour Authority to issue a works licence for tidal works at Baltic Wharf, Creeksea, Wallasea Island.
