This Notice replaces the one published on 10th September 1986, which contained an error in the description of the length of road to be stopped up.

SCHEDULE (all distances are approximate)

The highway to be stopped up is at Cardiff in the County of South Glamorgan and is that length of Llanmaes Street which extends from its junction with Clive Street in a general easterly direction for a distance of 37 yards.

The highway to be stopped up is at Pentrebach in the county of Mid Glamorgan and is that length of the access lane to the rear of Nos. 5-12 Tai Bach Cottages which extend from its junction with Duffryn Road for a distance of 65 yards.
