The City of Bristol (No. 20B) Smoke Control Order 1987

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Bristol in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 as amended by Paragraph 5 of the Second Schedule to the Local Government Planning and Land Act 1980, propose to make an Order entitled "The City of Bristol (No. 20B) Smoke Control Order 1987". The area covered by the proposed Order comprises parts of the St. George East Ward and parts of the St. George West Ward.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the proposed Order and by virtue of section 11 (4) of the Act, if on any day after the Order has come into operation smoke is emitted from chimneys of any property in the Smoke Control area the occupier of that property shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £400 unless he proves that the emission was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, low volatile steam coals, coke and other carbonised

anthracite, low volatile steam coals, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

After the Order has been made it will not come into operation before the expiration of a period of 6 months.

ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

NOTTINGHAMSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Nottinghamshire County Council (Bath Street, Carlton Road and Manvers Street Area, Nottingham) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1986

Notice is hereby given that the Nottinghamshire County Council has made an Order under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, the effect (relating to roads in the City of Nottingham) of which will be:

(1) vehicles will be prohibited from waiting at any time in part of

Bath street;

(2) vehicles will be allowed to wait for up to two hours (return prohibited within the following two hours) between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive in parts of Carlton Road and Manvers Street;

(3) vehicles proceeding in Southwell Road and Manvers Road will be prohibited from entering Avenue A, Avenue B and

(4) vehicles will be prohibited from making a left turn from Bath Street into Carlton Road and from making a right turn from Sneinton Road into Carlton road;

Sheinton Road into Cariton road;

(5) vehicles will be subject to one-way traffic restriction on Eyre Street and will be allowed to travel only from east to west (i.e. from Sneinton Road to Manvers Street).

The usual exemptions will be provided.
Relevant documents may be inspected at my Office or at the Office of the Secretary and Solicitor, Nottingham City Council, the Guildhall, Nottingham. Any person wishing to question the validity of the Order or of any of the provsions contained in it on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any Instrument made under it, has not been complied with in relation to the Order may, not later than 30th December 1986 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The Order will come into operation on 6th December 1986.
