HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

The Fishguard-Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road (Cardigan By-Pass) Order 198

The Fishguard-Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road (Cardigan By-Pass, Side Roads) Order 198

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he proposes to make the following Order:

1. An Order under sections 10, 12, 41 and 106 of the Highways Act 1980 providing:
 - a that a road approximately 2.05 kilometres in length which he proposes to construct commencing at Ridgeway on the A487 Trunk Road and proceeding in a north-easterly direction and rejoining the existing A487 Trunk Road in the vicinity of its junction with New Mill Road, all in the Town of Cardigan in the county of Dyfed;
 - b authority to construct as part of the road described at (a) above a bridge over the navigable waters of the River Teifi; and
 - c that by construction of the road described at (a) above the lengths of the Fishguard-Bangor (Menai Suspension Bridge) Trunk Road (A487) to be superseded shall cease to be a trunk road as from the date on which the Secretary of State notifies the Council Council of Dyfed (who will become the highway authority responsible for these lengths) that the said new trunk road is open for through traffic.
2. An Order under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980, authorising him:
 - a. to carry out the improvement of highways,
 - b. to stop up highways,
 - c. to construct new permanent highways,
 - d. to construct a temporary highway,
 - e. to stop up private means of access to premises, and
 - f. to provide new means of access to premises

all in the Town of Cardigan in the county of Dyfed, providing for the transfer of each of the said new permanent highways to the County Council of Dyfed, as from the date on which the Secretary of State notifies the Council that the said new permanent highways have been completed and are open for through traffic.

Copies of the draft Orders and relevant plans may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours from 11th December 1986 to 29th January 1987, or within 7 weeks from the date of publication of this notice, whichever period shall expire later, at the offices of Dyfed County Council, Council Offices, Aberaeron; Ceredigion District Council, Town Hall, Abersystwyth; Ceredigion District Council, Council Offices, Morgannwg, Cardigan; the Post Office, High Street, Cardigan and at the Welsh Office, Highways Directorate, Roads Administration Division, Phase 1, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff.

Any person may, not later than 29th January 1987 or within 7 weeks from the date of publication of this notice if such a period shall expire later, object to the making of either of the Orders by notice to the Secretary of State, Welsh Office Highways Directorate, Roads Administration Division, Phase 1, Government Buildings, Ty Glas Road, Llanishen, Cardiff CF4 5PL, quoting reference WR 11/2/161 and stating the grounds of objection. In the preparation of an objection and the statement of the grounds of objection, it should be borne in mind that the substance of any objection or representation may be communicated to other people who may be affected by it.
