Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment in exercise of the powers conferred on him by section 209 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 and all other powers enabling him in that behalf, propose to make an Order the effect of which will be to divert that part of footpath No. 14 in the Parish of Leek which commences at point A on the map annexed to the Order (grid reference SJ 9847 5664) approximately 46 metres to a point marked B on the map (grid reference SJ 9848 5660) to a new line commencing at the aforementioned point A and running in a portherly direction and aforementioned point A and running in a northerly direction and then in a north- north-westerly direction for approximately 27 metres to the point marked C on the map, then in a north-westerly direction for approximately 10 metres to the point D on the map then in a north-north-westerly direction for approximately 14 metres to the aforementioned point B on the
