SECTION 116 OF THE HIGHWAYS ACT, 1980

*Stopping-up of Part of the Highway in Cross Road,
Wimbledon, London S.W.19*

Notice is hereby given that an application will be made to the Wimbledon Magistrates' Court sitting at the Court House, Queen's Road, Wimbledon, London, at 2 p.m. on Wednesday, 14th January 1987 for an Order that part of the highway in the London Borough of Merton situated in Cross Road, Wimbledon, S.W.19 shall be stopped-up.

The area of highway to which this application applies comprises part of the footways and carriageway with an average width of 2 metres across the full width at the east end of Cross Road together with a parcel of footway and carriageway on the South Side of Cross Road extending west from the aforementioned strip for a distance of approximately 21 metres and reducing from 5 metres to nothing in a quasi-parabolic curve. The area of highway to which this application relates comprises approximately 91.6 square metres (109.5 square yards).

Notice is hereby given that the Rochdale Borough Council in exercise of the powers of the said Council intend to apply to the Magistrates' Court at Rochdale on 16th January 1987 at 2 in the afternoon for an Order under section 116 of the Highways Act 1980 authorising the diversion of part of Cowm Top Lane, Rochdale from a line running from Point A on the plan annexed to the application, being some 155 metres south of its junction with Queensway, for a distance of some 192 metres southwards to Point B to a line running from the said Point A eastwards for some 25 metres then southwards along the foot of the embankment of the A627(M) for some 153 metres then turning to run in a south-westerly direction for some 75 metres to Point B, a distance of some 253 metres.
