ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

WEST GLAMORGAN COUNTY COUNCIL

The West Glamorgan County Council (Bracken Road, Neath) (Prohibition of Waiting) and (Prohibition of Entry) Order 1987.

Notice is hereby given that the West Glamorgan County Council in pursuance of its powers as contained in the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 intend to make an Order the effect of which will be to:

(a) Introduce prohibition of waiting at any time on the following lengths of road:

Prohibition of waiting at any time

Harle Street, south side:

from the western kerb-line of Bracken Road for a distance of 5 metres in a westerly direction;

from the eastern kerb-line of Bracken Road for a distance of 5 metres in an easterly direction.

Bracken Road, west side, from the southern kerb-line of Harle Street for a distance of 50 metres in a southerly direction.

Bracken Road, east side, from the southern kerb-line of Harle Street for a distance of 15 metres in a southerly direction.

(b) prohibition of entry of any vehicle into Bracken Road unless requiring access to land or premises in or on the road.

A copy of the proposed Order, statement of reasons and a relevant plan may be inspected during normal office hours in the County Clerk's Department, County Hall, Swansea, and Neath Borough Council Offices, Civic Centre, Neath. Exemptions will be provided in the Order for essential services, loading and unloading facilities and disabled drivers' vehicles.

MELTON BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Melton Borough Council (Jubilee Street) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1987

Notice is hereby given that the Melton Borough Council proposes to make an Order under sections 1 (1) and (2), 2 (1) to (3) and 4 (2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

When the Order comes into effect it will prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on the length of road specified in the Schedule hereto.

Exceptions in the Order permit waiting for certain purposes including:

- (1) picking up and setting down passengers;
- (2) repair and maintenance work;
- (3) disabled persons;
- (4) loading and unloading goods.

Full details of these proposals are in the draft Order which together with a map and statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be examined at the Melton Borough Council Offices, The Borough Secretary and Clerk's Department, Nottingham Road, Melton Mowbray, Monday to Friday during normal office hours.
