## HIGHWAYS ACT 1980

*The County Council of Somerset (Frome Bypass Classified Road) (Side Roads) Order 1987*

Notice is hereby given that, the County Council of Somerset have made and have submitted to the Secretary of State for Transport for confirmation an Order under sections 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 for authorising the Council:

- (a) to improve, raise, lower or otherwise alter highways,
- (b) to stop up highways,
- (c) to construct new highways,
- (d) to stop up private means of access to premises, and
- (e) to provide new means of access to premises, all on or in the vicinity of the route of the classified road which the Council are proposing to construct as the Frome Bypass from a point on Bulls Quarries Road approximately 200 metres south-east of its junction with the Shepton Mallet-Frome road A361 at Frome generally eastwards and north-eastwards to a proposed round-about on the A36 Trunk road near Eastcott Farm, Beckington, together with a proposed spur road from the Frome Bypass to A361 near Bonnyleigh House.

Copies of the Order and of the relevant plans may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours from 30th January 1987, to 13th March 1987 inclusive at the Public Library, Scott Road, Frome, at County Hall, Taunton, and at the office of the Department of Transport, South West Region, Tollgate House, Houlton Street, Bristol, BS2 9DJ.

Any person may not later than 13th March, 1987 object to the confirmation of the Order by notice to the Secretary of State for Transport at the Department of Transport, South West Region, Tollgate house, Houlton Street, Bristol, BS2 9DJ stating the grounds of objection.
