*The City of Carlisle (Eldred Street/Tullie Street)
(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1987*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Carlisle pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Cumbria in exercise of its powers under section 1(1) and (2), 2(1) (2) (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("The Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part (III) of Schedule 9 of the Act propose to make an Order the effect of which will be:

To prohibit waiting at all times on both sides of Eldred Street from its junction with Tullie Street for distances of 15m in each direction, and on both sides of Tullie Street, from its junction with Eldred Street for distances of 15m in each direction.

Exceptions will be provided in the Order to permit picking up and setting down of passenger, loading and unloading of goods, maintenance of roads, supply of gas, water and electricity and disabled persons' parking.

(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1987*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the City of Carlisle pursuant to arrangements made under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Cumbria in exercise of its powers under section 1(1) and (2), 2(1) (2) (3) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("The Act") and of all other enabling powers and after consultation with the Chief Officer of Police in accordance with Part (III) of Schedule 9 of the Act propose to make an Order the effect of which will be:

To prohibit waiting at all times on the south-west side of Blackfriars Street from a point 18m from its junction with Victoria Viaduct for a distance of 14m in a north-westerly direction.

SOUTHEND ON SEA BOROUGH COUNCIL PROHIBITION OF WAITING—NOTICE OF MAKING ORDER

*Borough of Southend-on-Sea (Imperial Avenue)
Prohibition of Waiting Order 1987*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the Borough of Southend-on-Sea made an Order on 4th February, 1987 pursuant to arrangements under section 101 of the Local Government Act 1972 with the County Council of Essex in exercise of the powers of the said County Council under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 ("the Act"), and of all other enabling powers, and after consultation with the chief officer of police in accordance with Part III of Schedule 9 to the Act the effect of which will be to prohibit waiting in parts of Imperial Avenue.

Exceptions in the Order permit waiting for the following purposes:—

- (a) Picking up or setting down passengers.
- (b) Loading or unloading goods.
- (c) Carrying out essential services connected with the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, water and electricity.
- (d) By disabled persons vehicles complying with the conditions set out in the Order.

The Order will come into effect on the 12th February, 1987.

A copy of the sealed order and the relevant map may be inspected at my office at the Civic Centre, Victoria Avenue, Southend-on-Sea.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained therein on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act of 1984 or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within 6 weeks from the 4th February, 1987 apply to the High Court for this purpose.
