ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The Secretary of State hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order entitled "The Trunk Roads (London-Edinburgh-Thurso Trunk Road (A167)) De-restriction Order 1984" under sections 82 (2) and 83 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be that the length of road specified in the Schedule to this notice shall cease to be subject to a speed limit of 30 m.p.h., which will automatically be imposed on this length of road by virtue of sections 81 (1) and 82 (1) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 when a system of street lighting (which is expected to be completed in March 1987), is installed.

This length of road is at present unrestricted.

A copy of the draft Order and a statement of the Secretary of State's reasons for proposing to make the Order may be inspected at all reasonable hours at the office of the Director (Transport), Northern Region, Wellbar House, Gallowgate, Newcastle-upon-Tyne, and of the County Engineer, Durham County Council, County Hall, Durham DH1 5UO.

Any person who wishes to object to the making of the Order must do so in writing to the Director (Transport), Northern Region, Wellbar House, Gallowgate, Newcastle-upon-Tyne NE1 4TD, quoting ref. DN 505328/1/T1/06, and stating the grounds of objection. The closing date for receipt of objections is 31st March 1987.
