Notice is hereby given that the South West Water Authority have formulated a proposal to abstract the following quantities of water from Spreycott Spring at N.G.R. Notice is hereby given that the South West Water Authority have formulated a proposal to abstract the following quantities of water from the River Tavy at N.G.R. SX475650 at Lopwell: 38,641 cubic metres (approximately 8,500,000 gallons per day) with a total of 12,501,700 cubic metres (approximately 2,750,000,000 gallons) per annum.
