PUBLIC HEALTH ACTS AND CLEAN AIR ACT

HARTLEPOOL BOROUGH COUNCIL

THE CLEAN AIR ACT 1956

The Borough of Hartlepool No. 34 Smoke Control (Variation No. 2) Order 1987

Notice is hereby given that the Hartlepool Borough Council in exercise of the powers conferred on them by section 11 of the Clean Air Act 1956 (hereinafter called the said Act) on 1st April 1987 made an Order entitled The Borough of Hartlepool No. 34 Smoke Control (Variation No. 2) Order 1987 which Order is about to be submitted to the Secretary of State for the Environment for confirmation.

The effect of the Order is to cancel the exemption of the buildings shown in the Schedule hereto from the provisions of the Borough of Hartlepool No. 34 Smoke Control Order 1978 and from the date of operation of the Order the said buildings shall be subject to the provisions of section 11 of the said Act.

Subject to the exemptions provided by the Order and by virtue of section 11(2) of the said Act if on any day after the Order has come into operation smoke is emitted from a chimney of any building shown in the Schedule hereto the occupier of that building shall be guilty of an offence and liable to a fine not exceeding £100 unless he proves that the emission of smoke was not caused by the use of any fuel other than an authorised fuel. The authorised fuels include anthracite, coke and other carbonised fuels, gas and electricity.

If confirmed the Order will not come into operation before 1st February 1988 or before the later date determined by the Secretary of State for the Environment.

Copies of the Order may be inspected free of charge at the offices of the Borough Solicitor, Civic Centre, Hartlepool during normal office hours during the period of 6 weeks from 1st April 1987.

Within the said period any person who will be affected by the Order may by Notice in writing to the Secretary of State for the Environment, 2 Marsham Street, London S.W.1 object to the confirmation of the Order.
