The M40 London—Oxford—Birmingham Motorway (Waterstock to Wendlebury Section) and Connection Roads Scheme 198

The M40 (London—Oxford) Motorway (Stockenchurch to Waterstock Crossroads Section) Variation Scheme 198

2. a Scheme under sections 16 and 326 of the Highway Act 1980 authorising him to vary the provisions of the M40 (London—Oxford) Motorway (Stockenchurch to Waterstock Crossroads Section) Scheme 1970 by deleting therefrom that part of the special road mentioned in Schedule 1 to the Scheme which extends for a distance of 242 yards eastwards from a point on the London—Fishguard trunk road (A40) 25 yards east of Waterstock Lane at Great Milton in Oxfordshire.
