MISUSE OF DRUGS ACT 1971, SECTIONS 13 AND 15

Extension of Temporary Direction Withdrawing Certain Powers in Relation to Controlled Drugs

In accordance with section 16(2) of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971, Notice is hereby given that Secretary of State has, in accordance with section 15(6) of that Act, further extended the period of operation of the following direction given in accordance with section 13 of that Act, which took effect on 5th December 1986 and was extended on 16th January, 13th February and 13th March 1987, for a period of 28 days commencing on 10th April 1987.

"The Secretary of State, in pursuance of subsection (2) of section 13, and by virtue of section 15, of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971, by this Direction prohibits Dr. Alan George Walker, MB, ChB, a doctor within the meaning of that Act, whose registered address is 44 Brighton Road, South Croydon, Surrey, from prescribing, administering and supplying and from authorising the administration and supply of any controlled drug within the
