The Trunk Road (A4042) (Malpas Road, Newport) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1987

Notice is hereby given that on 11th June 1987, the Secretary of State made the above order which will come into force on 23rd July 1987.

The effect of the Order is s stated in notice 4SI in the London Gazette No. 50885, dated 8th April 1987.

If any person desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds:

- (a) that it is not within the powers of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or
- (b) that his interests have been substantially prejudiced by a failure to comply with any of the requirements of that Act,

Milton Keynes Development Corporation: Extinguishment of Public Rights of way over part of Bridleway No. 5 at Walton, Milton Keynes.

Notice is hereby given that the Secretary of State for the Environment, in exercise of his powers under section 23 of the New Towns Act 1981, proposes to make an order extinguishing the public rights of way over the following route shown by a broken black line on the map hereinafter referred to:

That part of Bridleway No. 5 in the Parish of Walton from a point marked A on the map being the bridleway's junction with Brickhill Street and approximately 400 metres south of the junction of Brickhill Street and Walton Road and running in a north easterly direction, for approximately 950 metres, to a point marked B on the map being the bridleway's junction with Walton Road being approximately 950 metres east of Brickhill Street.
