delivering and collecting mail, to or from premises fronting the bus lane, by Post Office vehicles; any building or demolition operation, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the roads and the supply of gas, electricity and water and maintenance of any telecommunications apparatus; gaining access to off-street loading facilities or garaging, (using the shortest possible length of bus lane); loading and/or unloading goods at any premises fronting the bus lane using the shortest possible length of bus lane to gain access (other than those lengths of roads specified in items (b) and (c) of the Second Schedule to this notice).

All of the above vehicles shall proceed in a south-easterly direction in the bus lane.

Full details of these proposals are contained in the draft Orders which together with a map showing the roads affected and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Orders may be examined from Monday to Friday during normal office hours at:

(a) St. Owen's Street (north-eastern side)

- l) From a point 38 metres (125 feet) north-west of its junction with Gaol Street for a distance of 38-6 metres (127 feet) in a north-westerly direction.
- (2) From a point 175.6 metres (576 feet) north-west of its junction with Gaol Street for a distance of 15.3 metres (50 feet) in a north-westerly direction.
- (b) St. Owen's Street (south-western side), From a point 69 metres (226 feet) north-west of its junction with St. Ethelbert Street for a distance of 11-7 metres (38 feet)in a north-westerly direction.
