DERBYSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Derbyshire County Council (Various Roads, Chapel-en-le-Frith, Dove Holes, Martinside and Whaley Bridge Areas) (Weight Restriction) Order 1987

Notice is hereby given that on 6th August 1987, the Derbyshire County Council made an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(4) and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers.

The effect of this Order, which will come into effect on 10th August 1987, will be to prohibit any person from causing or permitting any goods vehicle the maximum permissible gross weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes to proceed in the lengths of road specified in the Schedule to this notice.

Exemptions are provided in the Order for:

- (a) The purposes of access to premises on or adjacent to the lengths of road;
- (b) The purpose of agriculture in connection with land adjacent to the lengths of road;
- (c) In connection with any building operation or demolition, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance, improvement or reconstruction, the laying, erection, alteration or repair of any sewer or of any main pipe or apparatus for the supply of gas, water or electricity or of a telegraphic line, as defined in the Telegraph Act 1878 in or adjacent to the lengths of road;
- (d) For fire brigade, ambulance or police purposes;
- (e) In the course of military training operations;
- (f) The passage of winter maintenance vehicles.

NOTE: The Derbyshire County Council (Various Roads, Chapel-en-le-Frith, Dove Holes, Martinside and Whaley Bridge areas) (Weight Restriction) Order 1977 is hereby revoked.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or of any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from 7th August 1987, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

DEVON COUNTY COUNCIL

The County of Devon (West Street, Tavistock) (Weight Restriction) Experimental Order 1987

Notice is hereby given that the Devon County Council propose to make an Order under section 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be that no person shall cause any goods vehicle, the gross laden weight of which exceeds 7.5 tonnes, to proceed other than in a north, easterly direction in West Street from its junction with Spring Hill to its junction with Russell Street.

The County of Devon (Bannawell Street/Drake Road/Pym Street, Tavistock) (Prohibition of Waiting) Experimental Amendment Order 1987

Notice is hereby given that the Devon County Council propose to make an Order under section 9 and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be:

- (1) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 10 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday on the length of road specified in Schedule 1 to this notice;
- (2) To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time on the lengths of road specified in Schedule 2 to this notice;
