## ROCHDALE BOROUGH COUNCIL

Metropolitan Borough of Rochdale (Various Streets, Milkstone Road CBAA, Rochdale) (Restriction and Prohibition of Waiting) (Borough) Order 1984

Notice is hereby given that the Rochdale Borough Council in exercise of powers under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1987 have made an Order which will introduce:

- (1) No waiting at any time on:
  - (a) Drake Street, northerly side, from its junction with Manchester Road to a point 30 metres east of its junction with Broadfield Street.
  - (b) Drake Street, southerly side, from its junction with Manchester Road for a distance of 25 metres in an easterly direction.
  - (c) Broadfield Stile, westerly side, from its junction with Drake Street for a distance of 15 metres in a north-easterly direction.
  - (d) Broadfield Street, easterly side, from its junction with Drake Street for a distance of 15 metres in a north-easterly direction.
  - (e) Drake Street, southerly side, from a point 15 metres west of its junction with Castlemere Street to a point 15 metres east of its junction with Suffolk Street.
  - (f) Castlemere Street, both sides, from its junction with Drake Street for a distance of 15 metres in a southerly direction.
  - (g) Mere Street, both sides, from its junction with Drake Street for a distance of 15 metres in a southerly direction.
- (h) Suffolk Street, both sides, from its junction with Drake Street for a distance of 15 metres in a southerly direction.
- Drake Street, northerly side, from its junction with Church Stile for a distance of 15 metres in a westerly direction.
- (j) Church Stile, both sides, from its junction with Drake Street for a distance of 15 metres in a northerly direction.
- (k) Drake Street, southerly side, from its junction with Maclure Road for a distance of 25 metres in a south-westerly direction.
- (I) Macture Road, westerly side, from its junction with Drake Street to its junction with Henry Street.
- (m) Henry Street, northerly side, from its junction with Milkstone Road for a distance of 25 metres in a westerly direction.
- Road for a distance of 25 metres in a westerly direction.
  (n) Henry Street, northerly side, from its junction with Ann Street
- to its junction with Maclure Road.

  (o) Henry Street, southerly side, from its junction with Milkstone Road to its junction with Ann Street.
- (p) Milkstone Road, both sides, from a point 15 metres south of its junction with Drake Street to its junction with Henry Street.
- (q) Ann Street, westerly side. from a point 15 metres south of its junction with Drake Street to its junction with Henry Street.
- (r) Ann Street, easterly side, from a point 15 metres south of its junction with Drake Street to its junction with Lower Tweedale Street.

- (2) Waiting limited to I hour, return prohibited within I hour, Monday to Saturday between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on:
  - Drake Street, southerly side, from a point 25 metres east of its junction with Manchester Road to a point 15 metres west of its junction with Castlemere Street.
- (3) Waiting limited to 2 hours, return prohibited within 1 hour, Monday to Saturday between 8 a.m. and 6 p.m. on:
  - Drake Street, southerly side, from a point 25 metres south-west of its junction with Maclure Road to a point 15 metres west of its junction with Ann Street.

The Order contains certain exemptions relating to emergency vehicles, disabled persons, statutory undertakers, loading and unloading, persons boarding and alighting from vehicles.

A copy of the Order and a map showing the lengths of road concerned may be inspected at the Information Office, Municipal Offices, Smith Street, Rochdale, between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 12.30 p.m. and 2 p.m. and 4.45 p.m. on Mondays to Fridays inclusive.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any Instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order you may within 6 weeks from 5th August 1987 apply to the High Court for this purpose.

The Order will come into effect on 23rd July 1987.
