*Epping Forest District (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 198*

*Epping:* Bakers Lane (East) Car Park; Bakers Lane (West) Car Park; Epping Sports Centre Car Park (Hemnal Street and Nicholl Road); Council Offices Car park (323 High Street).

*Loughton:* Burton Road (North) Car Park; Burton Road (South) Car Park; Church Hill Car Park; The Drive Car Park; High Beech Road Car Park; High Road (South) Car Park; Langston Road Lorry Park; Off Street Parking Places on Oakwood Hill Industrial Estate; Council Offices Car Park (Old Station Road); Smarts Lane Car Park; Traps Hill Car Park; Vere Road (North) Car Park and Service Yard; Vere Road (South) Car Park and Service Yard.

*Ongar:* Basons Lane Car Park; The Borough Vehicle Park; Pleasance Car Park.

*Roydon:* Harlow Road Car Park.

*Waltham Abbey:* Cornmill Car Park; Darby Drive Car Park; Quaker Lane Car Park; Waltham Abbey Swimming Pool Car Park (Roundhills).

*South Glamorgan County Council New Traffic Controls for the County of South Glamorgan*

## HEREFORD AND WORCESTER COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Hereford and Worcester (Hood Street and Quay Street, Worcester) Various Traffic Orders 1987*

Notice is hereby given that Hereford and Worcester County Council propose to make Orders under section 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 4(2), 32 and 35 of, and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 and of all other enabling powers the effect of which will be:

*(Hood Street, Worcester) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1987*

To prohibit waiting at any time on the following side and side of length of Hood Street in the City of Worcester in the County of Hereford and Worcester:

*Hood Street*

(a) north side, from its junction with South Parade to its junction with Quay Street;

(b) south side, from a point 25 metres (82 feet) north-east of its junction with South Quay to its junction with Quay Street.

Exemptions in the Order will permit waiting for the purpose of:

(a) picking up and setting down passengers;

(b) loading and/or unloading goods;

(c) delivering and collecting mail by Post Office vehicles;

(d) delivering and collecting furniture and effects with police consent;

(e) any building or demolition operation, the removal of any obstruction to traffic, the maintenance of the road and the supply of gas, electricity and water and maintenance of any telecommunications apparatus;

(f) the fire brigade, ambulance or police services;

(g) the pursuance of statutory powers or duties (if no other road can be conveniently used).

An exemption in the Order also permits the waiting by disabled persons' vehicles displaying a badge issued under the Local Authority's orange badge scheme for a limited period of two hours, return prohibited within a further period of one hour.

*Hood Street, Worcester (Street Parking Places) Order 1987*

To authorise the part of Hood Street, Worcester specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Notice to be used free of charge, as a parking place for such vehicles or classes of vehicles, in such positions, on such days and during such hours as specified in the said Schedule.
