WATFORD BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Borough of Watford (Town Hall and Former Hospital Site Access Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 198

Notice is hereby given that Watford Borough Council, acting as agents for the Hertfordshire County Council, propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which would be to amend the existing waiting restrictions in this area to enable the proposed integration of the Town Hall and former Peace Memorial Hospital car parks.

The precise nature of the proposals would be to amend the existing *No-Waiting at Any Time* restrictions operating in the exit road from the former Hospital site and Town Hall car park to Hempstead Road to read as follows:

Both sides, from its junction with Hempstead Road in a south-westerly direction of 80 metres.

NOTE: the remainder of the exit road would be incorporated in the new car park layout and the existing waiting prohibition on this section would cease to have effect.

Exemptions would permit waiting for:

- (1) Picking up or setting down passengers;
- (2) The loading and unloading of goods;
- (3) The carrying out of essential services related to road maintenance, the supply of gas, water and electricity and building, industrial or demolition operations;
- (4) Fire Brigade, Ambulance or Police purposes;
- (5) Disabled Drivers' vehicles displaying the requisite badge;
- (6) Vehicles in the use of the local authority in pursuance of its statutory powers or duties.

Details of the proposals are set out in the draft Order which together with the relevant map and a statement of the Council's reasons for the proposal to make the Order, may be examined during normal office hours at Room 38, Town Hall, Watford.

The remaining waiting prohibitions and restrictions contained in *The Borough of Watford (Town Hall and Hospital Access Roads) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Amendment) Order 1977* would be incorporated in the new Order.

The Borough of Watford (Town Hall and former Hospital Site Access Roads) (One-Way Traffic) Order 198

Notice is hereby given that Watford Borough Council, acting as agents for the Hertfordshire County Council, propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3) and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 the effect of which would be to amend the existing one-way traffic system operating in this area to enable the proposed integration of the Town Hall and former Peace Memorial car parks.

The precise nature of the proposals would be to prohibit the driving of vehicles specified in Column 1 of the Schedule to this Notice other than in the direction referred to in Column 2 of that Schedule. The remaining directional restrictions contained in the existing 1971 Order would be incorporated in the new Order.

WIGAN METROPOLITAN BOROUGH COUNCIL

The Wigan Borough (Wardley Street, Pemberton, Wigan) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 198

Notice is hereby given that the Wigan Borough Council, in exercise of the powers under section 1 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, proposes to make the Wigan Borough (Wardley Street, Pemberton, Wigan) (Prohibition of Waiting) Order 1987.

The effect of the Order will be to prohibit waiting at all times on Wardley Road, Pemberton, Wigan as follows:

West Side, from a point 15 metres south of the southerly kerbline in Ormskirk Road to Cross Street.

East Side, from a point 15 metres south of the southerly kerbline in Ormskirk Road for a distance of 20 metres.

There will be limited exceptions permitting vehicles to wait:

- (a) to enable people to board or alight;
- (b) for the purpose of building and similar operations, removing obstructions to traffic, road works and works by statutory undertakers;
- (c) for local authority, water authority and Post Office purposes;
- (d) if the vehicles are fire service or police vehicles or ambulances;
- (e) to take on fuel, water or air at any garage; or
- (f) for the delivery or collection of goods and for loading or unloading.

A copy of the proposed Order, and of the relevant map, and of a statement of the reasons for proposing to make the Order, and of the Orders to be revoked, may be inspected at the Civic Centre, Millgate, Wigan between 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. on any day from Monday to Friday.

Any objection to the Order must be made in writing and specify the grounds thereof and must be made to the Director of Administration, Civic Centre, Millgate, Wigan, not later than 21st September 1987.
