The Trunk Road (A477) (Llanteg, Dyfed) (De-Restriction) Order 1987

Notice is hereby given that on 24th August 1987, the Secretary of State made the above Order which will come into operation on 17th September 1987.

The effect of the Order is as stated in Notice 2 SI in the London Gazette No. 50904 dated 29th April 1987.

A copy of the Order and map may be inspected during normal office hours at the offices of South Pembrokeshire District Council, District Offices, Llanion Park, Pembroke Dock. (1 SI)

The Stopping-up of Highways (Butetown, Cardiff) Order 1987

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made the above Order under section 209 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 to authorise the stopping up of the highways described in the Schedule to this notice to enable development to be carried out.

Copies of the Order may be inspected free of charge at all reasonable hours at the offices of The City Planning and Development Department, Wood Street, Cardiff.

If any person desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds:

- (a) that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971; or
- (b) that his interests have been substantially prejudiced by a failure to comply with any of the requirements of that Act

he may within 6 weeks of 24th August 1987 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

SCHEDULE

(all distances are approximately)

The highways to be stopped up are at Cardiff in the County of South Glamorgan and are those lengths of highway consisting of the footways.

- Between numbers 18 and 24 Christina Street for a length of 34 yards and a width of 3.3 yards.
- 2. Between numbers 40 and 46 Maria Street for a length of 29 yards and a width of 3 yards.
- 3. Between numbers 36 and 38 Maria Street for a length of 15 yards and width of 5 yards.

- 4. Between numbers 104 and 110 Christina Street for a length of 29 yards and a width of 5 yards.
- 5. Between numbers 142 and 145 Bute Street for a length of 25 yards and a width of 10 yards. (2 SI)

THE IMPORTED FOOD REGULATIONS 1984

Health Mark: New Zealand

The Minister of Agriculture, Fisheries and Food and the Secretary of State for Wales acting jointly in exercise of the powers conferred on them by the Imported Food Regulations 1984 (SI 1984, No. 1918), give notice that they hereby recognise, subject to the conditions hereinafter set out, the health marks described in Part 1 of the Schedule hereto for the importation from New Zealand of meat and meat products as showing:

- (a) that the meat to which they relate, or the meat from which the meat product to which they relate was prepared, was derived from mammals inspected before and after death, or in the case of mammals killed when wild, was derived from mammals inspected after death only, in the country of origin of the meat and passed in accordance with criteria satisfactory to the Minister, and
- (b) that the dressing packing and other preperation of the meat or the meat product was carried out with all necessary precautions for the prevention of danger to health.
