ORRISDALE TERRACE

The north-east side of Orrisdale Terrace from its junction with College Road for a distance of 5 metres in a south-easterly direction.

The north-east side of Orrisdale Terrace from a point 29 metres south-east of its junction with College Road for a distance of 5 metres in a south-easterly direction.

The north-east side of Orrisdale Terrace from a point 80 metres south-east of its junction with College Road, to and around its closed end for a total distance of 47 metres.

The south-west side of Orrisdale Terrace from the extended south-eastern kerb-line of College Road for a distance of 8 metres in a south-easterly direction.

The south-west side of Orrisdale Terrace from a point 72 metres south-east of the extended south-eastern kerb-line of College Road for a distance of 18 metres in a south-easterly direction.

The north-east side of Orrisdale Terrace from a point 5 metres south-east of its junction with College Road for a distance of 24 metres in a south-easterly direction.

All that part of the north-east side of Orrisdale Terrace which is bounded on the north-east by so much of the edge of the carriageway as extends from a point 34 metres south-east of its junction with College Road for a distance of 46 metres in a south-easterly direction and which has a width throughout of 2 metres.

SANDFORD STREET

The north-east side of Sandford Street from its junction with Bath Road for a distance of 28 metres in a south-easterly direction.

The north-east side of Sandford Street from a point 112 metres south-east of its junction with Bath Road to its junction with St. Lukes Place.

The south-west side of Sandford Street, whole length.

All that part of the north-east side of Sandford Street which is bounded on the north-east by so much of the edge of the carriageway as extends from a point 72 metres south-east of its junction with Bath Road for a distance of 40 metres in a south-easterly direction and which has a width throughout of 2 metres.

ST. LUKES PLACE

The north-west side of St. Lukes Place, whole length from its junction with St. Lukes Road in a north-easterly direction to its closed end.
