This Order further amends the Warble Fly (England and Wales) Order 1982 by adding provisions which:

1. enable a veterinary inspector, where there are on any premises cattle which are suspected of being infected with warble fly, to serve a notice in Form A prohibiting the movement of any cattle from the premises or requiring them to be treated in respect of warble fly (article 2(a) and (b)(i));

- 2. enable a veterinary inspector, where he serves a notice in Form A on any person requiring him to treat cattle in respect of warble fly to require the treatment to be carried out between such dates during the autumn period (the period from 15th September 30th November inclusive in any year) as may be specified in the notice (article 2(b)(iii));
- 3. enable a veterinary inspector, where a notice in Form A has been served on any person prohibiting the movement of cattle from any premises, to serve a further notice on such person requiring the cattle to be treated in respect of warble fly (article 2(b)(iii)); and
- 4. enable a veterinary inspector, where he knows or suspects that at any time during the current calendar year before the beginning of the autumn period any cattle which have, or may have been, exposed to infection by warble fly were present on any premises to serve a notice in Form A requiring any cattle on those premises to be treated in respect of warble fly (article 2(c)).

cles, certain classes of bus and vehicles being used in connection with the maintenance of essential services and with the maintenance of the aforesaid lengths of High Street and Promenade.

(b) between the hours of 6 p.m. on any one day to 10 a.m. on the following day in respect of goods vehicles delivering goods the chowing day in respect of goods venices derivering goods to or collecting goods from premises adjoining the aforesaid lengths of High Street and Promenade, mechanical road cleansing vehicles and vehicles being used in connection with the maintenance of buildings adjoining the aforesaid lengths of High Street and Promenade.

The Order will contain exemptions from the driving restrictions in respect of the aforesaid length of Promenade

(a) in respect of security vehicles delivering or collecting cash or valuable securities to or from Banks or Building Societies adjoining the aforesaid length of Promenade.

(b) between the hours of 6 p.m. on any one day to 10 a.m. on the following day in respect of vehicles delivering or collecting goods to or from number 52 Promenade.

2. To impose a one-way traffic flow for vehicles at all times in the following lengths of road:

Length of Road Winchcombe Street (between its junctions with High Street and Albion Street) Pittville Street

Direction of One Way Flow From High Street towards Albion Street

From Albion Street towards High Street

3. To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time in the following lengths of roads:

High Street-between its junctions with Winchcombe Street and Regent Street.

Promenade-between its junctions with Imperial Circus and Cresent Terrace.

The Order will contain exemptions from the restriction referred to in paragraph 3 above for mechanical road cleansing vehicles, vehicles being used in connection with the maintenance of buildings adjoining the aforesaid lengths of road and of the maintenance of essential services, fire, ambulance and police vehicles, goods vehicles delivering goods to or collecting goods from certain premises adjoining the aforesaid lengths of road during the hours of 6 p.m. on any day to 10 a.m. on the following day and, in respect of the aforesaid length of Promenade only, there will be exemptions for certain classes of bus, vehicles delivering goods to or collecting goods from Number 52 Promenade and security vehicles delivering or collecting cash or valuables, to or from Banks and Building Societies adjoining the aforesaid length of Promenade.

4. To prohibit the waiting of vehicles at any time in parts of the following roads:

(a) High Steet, (b) Pittville Street, (c) Winchcombe Street.

5. To prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays in parts of the following roads:

(a) County Court Road, (b) Pittville Street, (c) Crescent Terrace, (d) Winchcombe Street.

The Order will contain exemptions from the restrictions referred to in paragraphs 4 and 5 above for disabled persons vehicles displaying the appropriate badge and parking disc and to enable goods to be loaded or unloaded.

- 6. To prohibit the waiting of vehicles between the hours of 8 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays for a period of more than 1 hour in any period of 2 hours in parts of the following roads:
 - (a) Pittville Street, (b) Winchcombe Street.

The Order will contain an exemption from the restriction referred to in paragraph 6 above in respect of disabled persons, vehicles displaying the appropriate badge.

The Order will contain exceptions from the restrictions referred to in paragraphs 4, 5 and 6 above, permitting waiting for the purposes of boarding or alighting, building industrial and demolition operations, roadworks, the maintenance of essen-tial services and telecommunications apparatus, the removal of obstructions to traffic, the delivery of postal packets by the Post Office, the removal of furniture and the posting or removal of advertising material.

7. To make consequential amendments to the exisitng waiting restrictions in parts of the following roads:

(a) County Court Road, (b) Pittville Street, (c) Promenade,

(d) High Street, (e) Crescent Terrance, (f) Winchcombe Street

8. To revoke the existing one-way traffic restrictions in the following lengths of road: (a) Pittville Street, (b) Winchcombe Street, (between its junc-

tions with High Street and Albion Street).

- 9. To revoke the existing driving restriction in respect of the boxed area at the junction of Pittville Street/Albion Street and Portland Street.
- 10. To revoke the existing restrictions in so far as they:

(i) prohibit vehicles of certain classes from proceeding along that length of Winchcombe Street which extends from its junction with Albion Street to its junction with High Street (ii) prohibit vehicles of certain classes from proceeding at certain times along that length of Bath Street which extends from its junction with Bath Road to its junction with Wellington Street
