The Stopping Up of Highways (Gilfach Iago, Saron, Dyfed) Order 1986

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made an Order under section 209 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 and section 32 of the Mineral Workings Act 1951 to authorise the stopping up of the highways described in the Schedule to this notice for a period not exceeding ten years to enable minerals to be worked by surface working, for which planning permission has been granted.

The Order requires the provision of a new highway which shall be a highway maintainable at the public expense, and for which Dyfed County Council shall be highway authority.

If any person desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds:

- that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971; or
- that his interests have been substantially prejudiced by a failure to comply with any requirements of that Act.

he may within 6 weeks of the 29th October 1987 apply to the High Court for the suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

SCHEDULE

(all distances are approximate)

The highways to be stopped up are at Gilfach Iago in the county of Dyfed. They are:

- that length of the unclassified highway Pontyblodau to Maesglas Pumping Station which extends from a point 12 metres north-west of the property known as "Gernant" in a general south-westerly direction for a distance of 1310 metres.
- that length of the unclassified link road between Saron Road and the Pontyblodau to Maesglas Pumping Station Road which extends from a point 34 metres north of the property known as "Nant Madryn" in a general south-easterly direction for a distance of 355 metres.
- that length of highway known as Saron Road which extends from a point 36 metres south of the property known as "Cwmbach" in a general south-westerly direction for a distance of 920 metres.

The London-Fishguard Trunk Road (Flether Hill-Southleys Improvement) Order 1987

The London-Fishguard Trunk Road (Flether Hill-Southleys Improvement, Side Roads) Order 1987

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made the following Orders:

An Order under sections 10 and 41 of the Highways Act 1980 providing that a road about 395 metres in length which he proposes to construct from a point on the A40 Trunk Road about 154 metres north of Camrose Crossroads extending in a northerly direction to a point about 90 metres south of the junction of the Trunk Road with the entrance to Windy Hill Farm in the Community of Rudbaxton in the county of Dyfed shall become a Trunk Road as from the date when the Order comes into force, and that the length of trunk road to be superseded shall cease to be a Trunk Road as from the date on which notice is given by him to the County Council of Dyfed (who will become the highway authority responsible for that length) that the new Trunk Road is open for through traffic.
