

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that on the application of the Bristol City Council, he proposes to make an Order under section 212 of the above Act to provide for the extinguishment of any right which persons may have to use vehicles on a length of Church Lane, Bedminster.

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make the following Orders:

1. An Order under sections 10, 12 and 41 of the Highways Act 1980 providing:
 - (a) that a road about 0.42 kilometres in length which he proposes to construct between Fairy Cross and Horns Cross, Alwington, in the county of Devon shall become a trunk road as from the date when the Order comes into force; and
 - (b) that a length of the Taunton-Fraddon A39 Trunk Road to be superseded by the new road referred to at (a) above shall cease to be a trunk road as from the date on which notice is given by him to the County Council of Devon (who will become the highway authority responsible for that length) that the said new road is open for through traffic.
2. An Order under sections 12, 14 and 125 of the Highways Act 1980 authorising him:
 - (a) to stop up highways;
 - (b) to construct a new highway;
 - (c) to stop up private means of access to premises; and
 - (d) to provide new means of access to premises,
 all between Fairy Cross and Horns Cross, Alwington, aforesaid, and providing for the transfer of the said new highway to the County Council of Devon as from the date on which he notifies the Council that the said new highway has been completed and is open for through traffic.
