Doctors Parking Place (No. 1) Order 1987

Notice is hereby given that Lewisham Borough Council on 3rd November 1987, made the above-mentioned Order under sections 45, 46, 49 and 124 of and Part IV of Schedule 9 to of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by section 8 of and Part I of Schedule 5 to the Local Government Act 1985.

The general effect of the Order will be to designate a parking place on the north side of Limes Grove between the party wall of Nos. 7 and 9 Limes Grove eastwards for a distance of 12 metres.

The Harrow (Prescribed Route) (Amendment No. 2) Traffic Order 198

Notice is hereby given, that the Council of the London Borough of Harrow propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6, 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, as amended by the Local Government Act 1985, and all other enabling powers.

The general effect of the Order would be to amend the Harrow (Prescribed Routes) (No. 1) Traffic Order 1982 and thereby exclude the access to the industrial sites in Cecil Road and Tudor Road from the restricted zone.

Exemption will be provided in the Order in respect of anything done:

- (a) with the permission or at the direction of a police constable in uniform; or
- (b) in accordance with any restriction or requirement indicated by traffic signs placed pursuant to section 66 or section 67 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
