

The amount which a local authority borrows within its annual quota will bear interest at the appropriate rate in the quota set of rates. Authorities may borrow further sums at quota rates at the discretion of the Public Works Loan Commissioners. Other borrowing beyond the quota entitlement will be at the appropriate rate in the non-quota set of rates.

My Lords concur.

The Treasury determine the rates of interest accordingly.

RATES OF INTEREST ON LOANS FROM THE NATIONAL LOANS FUND

NOTICE

The Treasury in pursuance of section 5 of the National Loans Act 1968 (as amended) hereby give notice that on or after 8th December 1987:

- (i) Different rates of interest shall apply according to whether the principal of a loan is repaid by instalments or at maturity and, if repaid by instalments, whether by equal instalments of the principal with interest paid on the decreasing balance of the principal (E.I.P.), or by instalments of equal repayments of the principal and interest paid thereon (E.R.);
- (ii) The lowest rates of interest satisfying the conditions laid down in section (3) of the said section 5 shall be:

The Stopping-up of Highways (Market Place, Blackwood, Gwent) Order 1987

The Secretary of State for Wales hereby gives notice that he has made the above Order under section 209 of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971 to authorise the stopping-up of the highways described in the Schedule to this notice to enable development to be carried out.

Copies of the Order may be inspected, free of charge, at all reasonable hours at the offices of Islwyn Borough Council, Civic Centre, Blackwood Road, Pontllanfraith, Blackwood, Gwent.

If any person desires to question the validity of the Order, or of any provision contained therein, on the grounds:

- (a) that it is not within the powers of the Town and Country Planning Act 1971; or
- (b) that his interests have been substantially prejudiced by a failure to comply with any of the requirements of that Act,

he may within 6 weeks of 11th December 1987 apply to the High Court for suspension or quashing of the Order or of any provision contained therein.

SCHEDULE

(all distances are approximate)

The highways to be stopped-up are at Blackwood in the County of Gwent and are:

- (a) that length of un-named highway lying to the east of Highland Terrace which extends from its junction with Woodbine Road in a general south-easterly direction for a distance of 45 metres;
- (b) that length of highway known as Gravel Lane which extends from a point 40 metres from the intersection of the centre line of Gravel Lane and the west channel of High Street in a general

westerly direction for a distance of 70 metres along the centre of Gravel Lane, and then in a general north-westerly direction for a distance of 40 metres; and

- (c) an area of highway connecting Gravel Lane and the service road to the bus depot which extends for a distance of 7 metres from the southern side of Gravel Lane.

NOTICE OF SEIZURE UNDER THE CUSTOMS AND EXCISE MANAGEMENT ACT 1979

To: MEDIMPEX FRANCE.

Pursuant to section 139(6) of the Customs and Excise Management Act 1987, and paragraph 1 of Schedule 3 thereto, the Commissioners of Customs and Excise hereby give notice that by virtue of the powers contained in the Customs and Excise Acts, certain goods namely:

15.10 kg. Phenobarbital

have been seized as liable to forfeiture by force of the following provisions namely: section 49(1)(b) of the Customs and Excise Management Act 1979 in that the said goods were on 30th January 1987 imported contrary to the prohibition for the time being in force with respect thereto by virtue of section 3(1) of the Misuse of Drugs Act 1971.

If you claim that the said goods are not liable to forfeiture you must within one month from the date of this notice of seizure give notice of your claim in writing in accordance with paragraphs 3 and 4 of Schedule 3 to the Customs and Excise Management Act 1979.

If you are outside the United Kingdom and the Isle of Man you must also give the name and address of a solicitor in the United Kingdom who is authorised to accept service of process and act on your behalf.

If you do not give notice of claim within the said period of one month or, if any requirement of the above-mentioned paragraph 4 is not complied with, the goods in question will be deemed to have been duly condemned as forfeited.

If you do give notice of claim in proper form, the Commissioners will take legal proceedings for the condemnation of the said goods.
