LEICESTERSHIRE COUNTY COUNCIL

The Leicestershire County Council (Copt Oak Road, (Part), Narborough) (Prohibition of Driving) Order 1987

Notice is hereby given that the Leicestershire County Council has made an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, the effect of which will be to prohibit any vehicle from proceeding in any direction in that length of road known as Copt Oak Road (Part) Narborough, which extends from a point 366 metres north-west of its junction with Homer Drive, in a north-westerly direction for a distance of 3 metres.

The alternative route available to all vehicles affected by the Order will be via the new distributor road (Hardwicke Road).

The Order will come into force on Friday, 18th December 1987.

A copy of the Order and the relevant map is available for public inspection at County Hall, Glenfield, Leicester.

If you wish to question the validity of the Order or of any provision contained in it on the grounds that it is not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirement of that Act or any instrument made under it has not been complied with in relation to the Order, you may, within 6 weeks from the date of this Notice, apply to the High Court for this purpose.

GOSPORT BOROUGH COUNCIL

Borough of Gosport Traffic Regulation Orders

Notice is hereby given that the Gosport Borough Council, as agents for the Hampshire County Council on 14th December 1987 made the following Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to 3 and 4(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as follows.

Borough of Gosport (Toronto Place) (Prohibition of Waiting at Any Time) (No. 7) Order 1987

Toronto Place. To extend the existing restriction to incorporate the full area of the hammerhead adjacent to ABBA Engineering.

Exemptions to the Order will permit waiting for certain purposes including:

- (a) picking up and setting down of passengers;
- (b) loading and unloading of goods;
- (c) building operations road and similar works;
- (d) the disabled.

A copy of the Order which comes into force on 18th December 1987, together with a map showing the lengths of road concerned together with the Council's reasons for making the Order may be inspected at the office of the undersigned during usual office hours.

Any person who wishes to question the validity of the Order of any of the provisions contained in it on the grounds that they are not within the powers conferred by the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984, or on the grounds that any requirements of that Act or any instruments made under it have not been complied with in relation to the Order may within 6 weeks from the date the Order was made, apply to the High Court for this purpose.
