TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 209 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of a length of Lewisham Close and Footpath Nos. 315 and 316, Swindon to enable development consisting of the conversion and extension of existing block of maisonettes to provide elderly persons group dwelling to be carried out by Thamesdown Borough Council under Part III of the said Act.
