*The Hillingdon (Waiting and Loading Restriction)
(Amendment No.) Order 1987*

Notice is hereby given that the Council of the London Borough of Hillingdon propose to make the above-mentioned Order under sections 6 and 124 and Part IV of Schedule 9 to the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 as amended by section 8 and Schedule 5 of the Local Government Act 1985.

The general effect of the Order will be further to amend the Hillingdon (Waiting and Loading Restriction) Order 1978 so that:

(a) in the length of street specified in Schedule 1 to this Notice, the waiting by vehicles for the purpose of delivering or collecting goods or loading or unloading a vehicle will be prohibited between 8 a.m. and 9.30 a.m. and between 4.30 p.m. and 6.30 p.m. on Mondays to Saturdays inclusive.
