ROAD TRAFFIC ACTS

BIRMINGHAM CITY COUNCIL

Birmingham City Council (Victoria Road, Aston) (Prohibition of Driving) and (Victoria Road, Aston) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) (Variation) Orders 198.
