

TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives Notice that on the application of the Derby City Council, he proposes to make an Order under section 212 of the above Act to provide for the extinguishment of any right which persons may have to use vehicles on part of Abingdon Street, Derby.

The proposed Order will contain provisions for permitting the use of those highways by vehicles being used:

- (a) for police, ambulance or fire brigade purposes:
- (b) in connection with the laying, erection, inspection, maintenance, alteration, repair, renewal or removal in or near the said length of highway of any sewer, main, pipe, conduit, wire, cable or other apparatus for the supply of gas,

water, electricity or of any telecommunication apparatus as defined in Schedule 2 to the Telecommunications Act 1984. and for use by pedal cyclists.

During 28 days from 20th April 1988 copies of the draft Order and relevant plan may be inspected at the offices of the Derby City Council, The Council House, Derby and may be obtained free of charge from the Secretary of State at the address stated below.

Within the above-mentioned period of 28 days, any person may by notice to the Secretary of State, Department of Transport (Ref: EMCM 5050/41/17/06, East Midlands Region, Cranbrook House, Cranbrook Street, Nottingham NG1 1EY, object to the making of the Order.
