The City of Plymouth (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1988

Notice is hereby given that on 15th April 1988, Plymouth City Council made an Order under section 35 and Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984 to effect a consolidation and revision of the City of Plymouth (Off-Street Parking Places) Order 1986 and the Amendment Order thereto to bring car parks at Western Approach, Radford Road, and the Civic Centre, within the scope of the Order. The Order also regulates the use of free parking at Whittleigh Green, Leigham, and Elburton-Haye Road South car parks.

The Order also effects changes in respect of existing car parks, namely the alteration of the short-term car park on decks 6 and 7 of the Theatre Royal car park to long-term parking, and the alteration of part of the Mudge Way car park from short-term to long-term car parking.

The Order will come into operation on 1st May 1988.

The Order also effects changes in the scale of charges for car parks as detailed in the Schedule to this notice, all other car parks included in the Order being operated without any charge being payable.

The Order has been made in accordance with the proposal published in the London Gazette on 2nd March 1988 (Ref. 724) without any modification.
