

Exemptions will permit waiting for picking up or setting down passengers, loading or unloading goods, disabled persons' vehicles bearing the relevant "orange badge", Post Office vehicles delivering and collecting mail, emergency Service vehicles and where necessary, in connection with any building or demolition operation, the maintenance of the road, the supply of gas, water or electricity and works to any telecommunications apparatus.

#### DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Dorset (Various roads, Sherborne) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1988*

Notice is hereby given that the Dorset County Council have made an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) to (3), 4(2) and 124(1) (d) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

The effect of the Order will be to:

- (a) Revoke that part of "The County of Dorset (Various Streets, Sherborne) (Traffic Regulation) Order 1966 relating to the prohibition of waiting between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 6 p.m. Mondays to Saturdays on Long Street on its southern side between points 35 and 47 metres west of its junction with St Swithin's Road.
- (b) Revoke that part of "The County of Dorset (Various Streets, Sherborne) (Prohibition and Restriction of Waiting) Order 1978" relating to the prohibition of waiting between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday on St Swithin's Road on both sides from its junction with Long Street northwards for a distance of 15 metres.
- (c) Prohibit waiting at any time on the following lengths of road:
  - (i) *George Street*, on both sides, from its junction with Coldharbour southwards for a distance of 35 metres;
  - (ii) *Bristol Road*, on both sides, from a point 83 metres north of its junction with Coldharbour northwards to its southern junction with Priestlands;
  - (iii) *Pageant Drive*, on both sides, for its entire length;
  - (iv) *Station Road*, on its western side, from its junction with Pageant Drive southwards to its junction with the southwestern arm of Station Road;
  - (v) *Long Street*, on its southern side, between points 35 and 47 metres west of its junction with St. Swithin's Road with an exemption for doctors in possession of a current parking permit;
  - (vi) *Horsecastles*, on both sides, for a distance of 15 metres either side of Durrant Close;
  - (vii) *St. Swithin's Road*, on both sides, from its junction with Long Street Northwards for a distance of 15 metres.
- (d) Limit waiting to 2 hours (return prohibited within 2 hours) between the hours of 9.30 a.m. and 6 p.m. Monday to Saturday on the northern side of Station Road from a point 243 metres south and east of its junction with the southern side of Cooks Lane north-eastwards to its junction with the northern arm of Station Road.

*The County of Dorset (40 m.p.h. speed limit) (No. ) Order 198 (Cabot Lane, Poole)*

#### DORSET COUNTY COUNCIL

*The County of Dorset (Cobb Road, Lyme Regis) (Weight Restriction) Order 1988*

Notice is hereby given that the Dorset County Council propose to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(4) and 3(2) of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.
