PORTSMOUTH CITY COUNCIL

*The Portsmouth (Frederick Street/Marketway)
(Prescribed Route) (No. 28) Order 1988*

Notice is hereby given that the Portsmouth City Council propose to make the above Order under the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984. The effect will be as follows:

Frederick Street

It is proposed that the junction of Frederick Street with Marketway be opened to allow certain traffic movements.

On reaching the junction with Marketway vehicles proceeding in a southerly direction in Frederick Street will only be able to turn left into Marketway. There will be 'no entry' into Frederick Street from Marketway.

Reasons for making the Order

To allow taxis using a proposed 8 car rank in Andrew Bell Street to leave the area by making a left turn onto Marketway from Frederick Street.

A copy of the draft Order and a plan may be examined at the Information Desk, Civic Offices, Portsmouth, during normal office hours.

Persons wishing either to object to or to support these proposals may do so by sending their representations in writing to the City Secretary and Solicitor, Civic Offices, Portsmouth, by 1st September 1988 stating the grounds of objection/support.

Under the provisions of the Local Government (Access to Information) Act 1985, any letters of representation which are received may be open to inspection by members of the public.

POWYS COUNTY COUNCIL

*(The County of Powys Market Street and Castle Road, Builth Wells)**(Prohibition of Waiting) Order 19*

Notice is hereby given that the County Council of Powys proposes to make an Order under sections 1(1) and (2), 2(1) and (2) and 4(2) and Part IV of Schedule 9 of the Road Traffic Regulation Act 1984.

When this Order comes into effect it will be unlawful to leave a vehicle at any time along any of the sides of the lengths of road known as Market Street and Castle Road, Builth Wells, specified in the Schedule to this notice.

Exceptions in the Order will permit waiting for as long as it is reasonably necessary for the following purposes:

- picking up and setting down passengers;
- loading or unloading goods;
- building and demolition operations and
- carrying out essential works connected with the maintenance of the roads and the provision of water, gas, electricity and telecommunications services.

The existing waiting restrictions in Market Street, Builth Wells, will be incorporated in the Order.

The Order will also contain an exception permitting disabled persons' vehicles to park for periods not exceeding 2 hours with return within 1 hour prohibited.

The details of these proposals are contained in the draft Order which, together with a map showing the lengths of road concerned and a statement of the Council's reasons for proposing to make the Order, may be examined during office hours at:

Powys County Hall, Llandrindod Wells and The Post Office, Builth Wells.

If you wish to object to the proposed Order you may send the grounds for your objection in writing to the undersigned by 8th September 1988.

*Lengths of road in the Community of Builth Wells in the Borough of Brecknock**Market Street (County Classified Road No. 124)*

- The north side thereof, which extends from a point approximately 54 metres (59 yards) east of its junction with Brecon Road for a distance of approximately 52 metres (57 yards) in an easterly direction to its junction with castle Road.
- The south side thereof, which extends from a point approximately 108 metres (118 yards) east of its junction with Brecon Road (that is at the western boundary of no. 48, Market Street) for a distance of approximately 10 metres (11 yards) in an easterly direction to its junction with Castle Road.

Castle Road (County Classified Road No. C124)

- The north side thereof, which extends from its junction with Market Street for a distance of approximately 100 metres (109 yards) in an easterly direction to the entrance to Builth Castle.
- The south side thereof, which extends from its junction with Market Street for a distance of approximately 40 metres (44 yards) in an easterly direction to the eastern boundary of the property known as "Greenfield"
