TOWN AND COUNTRY PLANNING ACT 1971

The Secretary of State for Transport hereby gives notice that he proposes to make an Order under section 209 of the above Act to authorise the stopping up of a section of Richmond Street, Totterdown adjacent to No. 2 Richmond Street to enable development consisting of the conversion of the existing house into 3 flats and construction of new end terrace house with 3 flats to be carried out in accordance with planning permission granted to John Graham by Bristol City Council under Part III of the said Act.

The proposed Order will require the provision of a new footway maintainable at the public expense for which the Highway Authority is to be the Avon County Council.
