together with all navigable rivers, canals and cuts downstream of Wisbech Bridge running into the waters of the Wash within the above mentioned limits, and including all tidal and closed docks within such limits but excluding any waters within the limits of compulsory pilotage of the King's Lynn Conservancy Board and the Port of Boston Authority.
