ROAD TRAFFIC REGULATION ACT 1984

The Trunk Road (A30) (Prohibition of U-turns) Order 1988

The Secretary of State for Transport made this Order on 28th October 1988, coming into force on 14th November 1988. The notice of the proposal to make it (ref. T8987/28R/0600) was published in issue No. 51098 of the *London Gazette* on 22nd October 1987 and the effect of the Order is as described in that notice.
